INTERNATIONAL NEWS.

NEW YORK. Upton Sinclair's new book "No Pasaran" has taken the country by storm. Sinclair glorifies the heroic fighters for Spanish Democracy.

MILAN. A. Toscanini famous conductor of the New York Philharmonic orchestra has spit in Mussolini's face by refusing to attend the 70th anniversary of the opera "La Scala". He refuses to conduct the fascist hymn because he considers it rubbish.

PORTO-RICO. Police charged a meeting of anti-imperialists which had been banned. 7 killed 125 wounded.

PARIS. Official circles in this city say that Mussolini's position in this city is becoming untenable. He must either continue shipping troops and supplies in such quantities that London would object, or he must admit he has lost his gamble.

LONDON. In answer to the British note of a few days ago about the landing of Italian troops at Cadiz, Mussolini stated that they were only medical volunteers and supplies.

UNIFICATION OF SPANISH YOUTH.

In Murcia, Ciudad Real and Aguilas, alliances of all youth anti-fascist organisations (soc. com. repub. and Anar.) have been formed. In Madrid on Monday next several conferences with the object of youth unification will take place.

SALAMANCA. The Fascist Junta has ordered that all gold in their territory, and all that is in hiding abroad should be handed over to them.

NEWS FROM THE FRONTS.

ANDALUCIA. SOUTHERN FRONT. After resisting several Fascist attacks the day before yesterday, our troops began to attack yesterday near Pozoblanco, in the first hour we advanced 3 kilometers. This attack is not yet over. Victory is absolutely necessary, because the Fascists attacked on this part of the front with all their forces.

GUADALAJARA. 50 of our planes bombed MONTANARES, with 450 bombs and fired 15,000 rounds of machine gun fire. The material damage to the enemy was very large.

ASTURIA. Large numbers of soldiers and civilians came over to us.

PARIS. News received from the Balearic Islands state of the existence of an Italian Air Base, and of the complete control of the Islands by Italy.

LATEST NEWS.

BERLIN. The German Minister of War Economy resigned because he could not finance the Spanish Fascists.

LONDON. "The Manchester Guardian" estimates the number of Italians killed at Guadalajara as 3000.

LONDON. The Trade Unions have put forward a demand that the Government should assist the Spanish Democratic Government.

LONDON. The attitude and statement of the Italian representative Grandi the other day has caused great uneasiness throughout the world. The "STAR" declares that British and Italian relations have never been so strained. At the next Parliamentary meeting the Spanish situation will be discussed.

PARIS. The famous journalist Portinax, states that the ability of the Spanish troops has endangered Mussolini's prestige, and he thinks to overcome this by sending fresh troops.

The "Humanity" states that France must declare that she will not stand for the Italian and German adventure in Spain.

MOSCOW. The Soviet Ambassador in London has presented a note to the Non-Intervention Committee in which he states that it is necessary to find out how many Italian troops there are in Spain, and that the Italian aggression is not yet finished. Italy hoped to bluff the Powers by threats of war, but the attitude of U.S.S.R. has been hysterical.
