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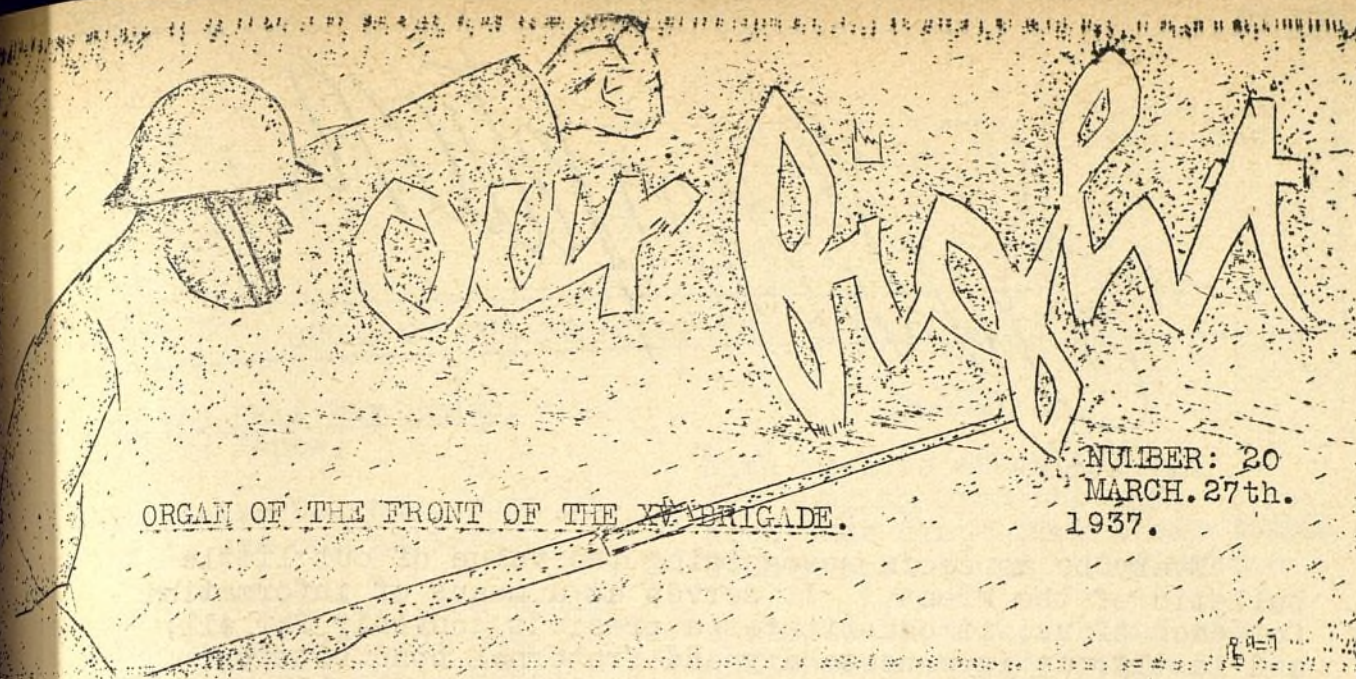

NEWS FROM THE FRONTS.

GUADALAJARA. March 24th. Improved weather enabled our troops to advance, although some resistance was met, due to the replacement of Italian troops by others. Since then we have been fortifying our positions.

ANDALUCIA. Now progress is reported from the sectors here. ANDUJAR March 26th. Our troops have advanced 4 km. in the direction of ALCARACEJOS and 5 km. in the direction of VILLANUEVA. In addition our aircraft has destroyed a munition train near MONTORO, this had been derailed an hour before through sabotage, near the Guadalquivir Bridge.

CORDOVA. Late yesterday evening it was reported that our troops had advanced another 3 km.

ALMERIA. The big success of the capture of STERRA DEL TORO is reported.

CIUDAD REAL. The fascist planes which refuse to fight our planes, continue to victimise the civil population. Yesterday they attacked ALCAZAR DE SAN JUAN, killing several women and children.

SEVILLA. Here, as at Alcazar San Juan, yesterday they killed several women and children.

SEVILLA. Our planes played havoc on the enemy in the Central station near Hondanares and Gogollor.

BARCELONA. Fascist planes again bombed Catalan towns dropping bombs.

International News.

LONDON. at the regular weekly meeting of the Cabinet, the only subject for discussion was the refusal of Italy to withdraw its volunteers from Spain. Eden declared that as a result of this refusal relations between Italy and England were strained.

PARIS. The Italian General, Bergonzoli, who bravely captured Addis Ababa from women armed with babies and men with knives, was in command of the fleeing Italians at Guadalajara. He has been removed, and Franco has taken command.

LONDON. "El Liberal" writes that between Germany and Italy relations are becoming strained. It is recalled that in 1914 Italy turned her back on Germany, is Germany going to do the same now? It is clear that in the financial position she is now, Germany can neither afford to continue financing Franco, or conduct a war against the coalition of democratic countries. Germany has tried to proceed by threats of war, but U.S.S.R. has called her bluff, and she has had to climb down. But the degree in which Germany will withdraw is problematical, and there must be no illusions. The proletariat of Spain and the workers of the world alone will decide the fate of the Spanish Republic.

NON-INTERVENTION COMMITTEE. They are still discussing, France and Great Britain are still hoping, and are trying to persuade Italy and Germany.

GERMANY. Goering's newspaper already shows that the Italian defeat at Guadalajara has caused considerable confusion in the
