Food is a weapon comrades, let us use and care for it as we would our rifles.

News from the Fronts.

MADRID. The day was again spent in improving the strength of our positions. Several fascists desertors passed over to our lines. Our aircraft engaged in reconnaissance flights.

SOUTHERN FRONT. Our troops are continuing their advance in the direction of ALCARACEJOS, which is of much strategic importance. They are now only 4 Km. away.

VALENCIA. Our aircraft bombed Zaragoza, causing several fires of military importance.

GIRON. The government has ordered the mobilisation of 4,000 workers for the construction of fortifications.

OVIEDO. Our artillery has destroyed three fascist guns, and thus further increased the strength of the fascists surrounded in the town.

International News.

LONDON. The "Manchester Guardian" writes that a plot has been discovered aimed at the Burgos Junta. The centre of the plot was in the Malaga district. 18 have been shot. It is obvious that behind the rebel lines there is a lot of trouble.

MADRID. Yesterday there was a large meeting of Left Republicans, in which communists and socialists took part. It was unanimously agreed that the Popular Front was the only way to victory.

VALENCIA. The socialist newspaper "Adelanto" writes that - "The socialists and Trade Unions (U.G.T.) are not and never will be anti-communist."

WARSAW. Anti-Jewish demonstrations have taken place.

BERLIN. The recall of the Vatican ambassador shows how serious has become the tension between Hitler and the Pope. This Sunday -Easter- sermons were read in churches against the Nazi regime. The protestants also are opposed to religious restrictions.

RABAT. In Spanish Morocco the rebel control has caused a severe famine among the native population, which is leaving the country in thousands.

TOKYO. Owing to vigorous action by U.S.S.R. the Japanese government has been forced to take steps to adopt a more peaceful attitude.
