## News From the Fronts.

**SOUTHERN FRONT.** Our advance continues, further ground beyond El Doldado has been taken, including a number of lines. Now we are approaching

Rejoui, which is expected to fall in our hands any time now. Our aircraft has severely bombed

**GUADALAJARA.** Yesterday when we captured Ledanca many stores - bombs - cartridges etc. - fell into our hands. In our fascist deserters have come over our lines.

## Revolts Behind the Fascists.

**BARCELONA.** It is reported that the fascist General Orgas has resigned. A new indication of the dissatisfaction in the rebel camp.

**ST. QUENTIN.** In the St. Quentin barracks demonstrations against Franco and his German and Italian officers have taken place. The result of this is the shooting of 1 Spanish soldier, 5 N.C.Os. and 12 Spanish soldiers.

**THE DAILY TELEGRAPH.** Reports that every hour the guerrilla fight behind the fascist lines becomes more intense, especially in Cadiz, where the anti-fascist units have organised considerable

fighting. It writes that the feeling between the Spanish and Italians is very bad and that there are shootings every day.

Reuter reports that at Malaga 20 Italian soldiers and several N.C.Os. of the Italian regiment Pavia have been shot.

**GIBRALTAR.** The officer in charge of the executions at Algeciras has committed suicide. Some comrades managed to erect a Republican flag in this town.

## International News.

**LONDON.** The "Manchester Guardian" writes that the situation of Franco becomes worse every day.

**VALENCIA.** Del Vayo has announced his intention of sending all Italian documents found at Guadalajara to the Non-Intervention Committee to forcing them to recognise that there is concrete evidence of the Italian

**WALDEBURG (GERMANY)** 280 have been imprisoned for expressing sympathy with Spain.

**LONDON.** It is stated that the full sea control of Spain will commence on April 5th.

## Wireless (B.B.C.) Items.

**LONDON.** A railway accident occurred at Queens Rd. Bridge yesterday, 7 killed and 21 wounded including many very seriously injured.

**GLASGOW.** The engineers strike previously reported is at Boardmores. Other works are levying themselves 1/- per member per week to assist the strikers.

**M.F.C.B.** has turned down the proposals of the Notts Miners' Unions, and are having a national ballot on April 15th & 16th. to decide on strike action on this matter, and also on the victimisation of the Haworth workers.

**U.S.A.** No agreement was reached yesterday between the owners and the coal-workers. Lewis states that the 400,000 striking miners will not return to work until a new wage and conditions agreement is signed.

**VALENCIA.** Another ambulance has been offered to the Catalan Govt. by the American Friends of the Spanish Republic.
