ORGAN OF THE FRONT OF THE XV BRIGADE.

The Recovery of Re-employable Material is an Anti-fascist Duty.

All our comrades will have noticed the enormous quantity of material, most widely assorted - clothes, bread, food, bayonets, gas-mask parts, cartridge cases etc. - which strew our trenches and the immediate neighbourhood of the front. Probably the same thought has struck each of us that is the waste of it all.

Unfortunately it really is a waste, and a waste all the more criminal because we are at war, and in a situation when it is necessary to adopt the economy of war.

We must not forget that the Spanish people have denied themselves so that they could rigidly apply the slogan of "EVERYTHING FOR THE FRONT".

If we are comfortably clothed, if we are generously supplied with food and ammunition, we owe it to the heroic sacrifices self-imposed by a people inspired by a unanimous will to win.

Of course it is not enough just to state the above facts. It is urgent that we apply the remedy, an end to waste, an act unworthy of the Popular Army. And then let us recover everything which can be possible re-employed, especially empty cartridge cases which are lying about our trenches in thousands, making them real copper mines.

Copper is a scarce and always a particularly precious metal for a country at war, because it is used in the manufacture of all munitions. We don't and can't want to leave such riches.

Everyone to work then, comrades! Every case saved is a new anti-fascist bullet which will assist on our victory.

MILK CONSUMPTION IN ENGLAND.

The Committee on Nutrition has submitted its report. In the course of this it states the necessary minimum of milk per day is 2 pints for expectant mothers, 1/2 pints for children and half a pint for

rest of the population. The actual consumption averages half a pint per head per day, and is less than many other countries.

News From the Fronts.

SOUTHERN FRONT. Another big advance. Our troops have advanced 8 km. in the direction of Villaharta and have captured the heights of Buenavista. We are now only 7 km. from Villaharta. Our aircraft has bombed the fascist barracks at Cordoba, dropping 40 bombs, and succeeded in destroying quantities of munitions.

MADRID. The Government gained 2 km. on the road to La Caruna.

GIJON. In the Semiedo sector we have advanced 7 km. This advance has cut the fascist lines of communication between the provinces of Leon and Asturias. In the Oviedo sector our artillery has severely bombarded the fascist positions.

BILBAO. There has been much fighting here, the fascists have been continually attacking, but have not managed to break through.

SOUTHERN FRONT. Further news states that in the direction of Penarroja we have taken the hill of Alcornocosilla.

VALENCIA. The S.R.I. is sending 240 tons of foodstuffs to Spain.

LONDON. The Spanish Ambassador in London has sent the documents to the Committee of Non-intervention proving Italy's intervention here. General Miaja declared that thousands of such documents had been sent to London and Paris.

BELGRADE. The Little Entente at the meeting yesterday studied the Spanish position. At Zagreb a huge anti-fascist demonstration directed against Italy took place.

WASHINGTON. The Mexican government has declared to the U.S.A. that it will continue giving the Spanish Government moral and material support.

TOKIO. All the employees of the Ayuntamiento de Madrid are out on strike for a 25% increase in wages.

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
