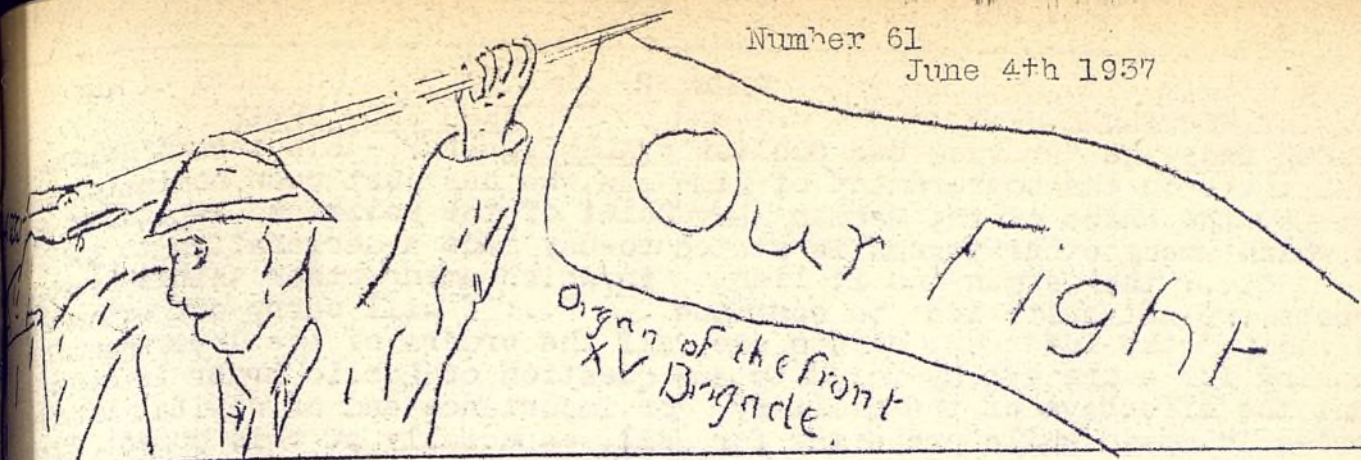

a call to the workers Internationals
FORWARD WORKING PEOPLE OF THE WORLD WITH THE PEOPLES OF SPAIN

Specialist: The Socialist Party, the Communist Party, and the U.G.T.
have sent the following message to the Socialist International the Communist
International, and the International Federation of Trade Unions and all
the National sections:-

"An infamous aggression, which supersedes all those known invasions
of our soil by German and Italian fascism, has been committed by the ships
of the German Navy which were carrying out the control in the waters of
Spain. In face of this act, which so irrefutably expresses the hellish
designs of fascism, we, in the name of the workers and peasants of Spain,
all the working masses of the country, who are fighting in the vanguard against
national and international fascism in defence of their liberty and are
defending the worlds proletariat from a ferocious war, call to you, comrades
of the Socialist International, Communist International, International Fed-
eration of Trade Unions, and all the militant proletariat of the workers
parties and Trade Unions, to intensify your support for Spain in order to
put an end to such violent attacks, carried out in this criminal manner,
against its defenceless people.

We ask you to bring pressure to bear on your governments that
they will act with energy against the fascist governments, who have attacked
with a violence rarely witnessed against the civil population taking the
lives of old people, women and children. From you, who are the vanguard of
the worlds proletariat, we demand more resolute common action to mobilise
the proletarian solidarity of the peoples of the world so that the plans
of fascism shall not be carried out and that Humanity shall not be engulfed
in a fresh world conflagration.

--- GENERAL MOLA IS DEAD ---

Radio News: It was announced from the Rebel Radio Station Salamanca
that in a fatal plane crash on the Northern Front of Bilbao was General
MOLA and three of his staff officers. All are dead.

MOLA was the General in Command of the Fascist forces in
North of Spain. After Franco he was the most important of the
Fascist Generals. He it was who organised the campaign against the Basque
country and he was responsible for the inhuman slaughter inflicted in the
discriminate bombings of open towns and villages. This death is a great
blow to the fascist countries especially to Germany whose orders he executed,
staking all on his efforts to win the industrial north for the fascists.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

NEWS FROM SPAIN

MOSCOW 2nd: The "Pravda" has published an article on the bombardment of Almeria by the ships of the German Navy in which among other things is stated ".... the German and Italian

troops are not sufficient to continue the war and the interventionists are looking for a pretext by which to augment the effective of the military forces in Spain while preparing for new expeditions of regular troops, warships and airplanes.

LONDON 2nd: The correspondent of the "News Chronicle" has telegraphed from San Sebastian that, in this town, there are grave disorders among the Italian soldiers who have demanded that they be repatriated. 200 arrests have taken place.

BRUSSELS 1st - The General Council of the Socialist Party has voted a resolution on the recent events in Spain and makes an appeal for all possible forms of aid to be

PARIS 2nd - The Communist Party of France has published an appeal on the bombardment of Almeria and calls for a pact of mutual assistance to be applied owing to the fact that Spain, a member of the League of Nations, has been openly attacked.

NEW YORK 2nd - 90,000 workers from three steel factories in YOUNGSTOWN and INLAND STEEL are on strike for the recognition of their industrial trade union. The strike area is extended over 5 Federal States and 15 towns.

The directors of the industrial Committee are prepared for a long strike and are making appeals to all Trade Unions to give every aid to the steel workers.

ZURICH 3rd - The correspondent of the "Daily Express" who visited the mother of the German aviator Wandell in Silesia has been arrested by the Gestapo accused with having tried to draw from the mother of WANDELL, who it will be remembered was condemned to death by the Basque Government, certain tendentious declarations.

ROME 3rd The Government of Italy has declared that it will return to the place in the Committee of Non-Intervention in London provided they receive formal guarantees of security for their ships from the Government of Valencia.

PARIS 3rd The comrade DEL VAYO, Chief of the delegation of Republican Spain to the League of Nations, was received by LEON BLUM, President of the French Council. At the end of their meeting, which lasted more than an hour, comrade DEL VAYO stated that the meeting had been more than cordial.

VALENCIA 3rd: - Lieutenant Colonel ORTIGA, who has just been nominated the Chief of the Police of Republican Spain to-day made a declaration to the press in which among other things he stated

"... I will carry out with energy all the orders of the Government. The question of Public Order is one of major importance and of capital interest, all, especially at this moment. There in the trenches is being forged the popular victory. It is strange that one should find the rearguard putting the final triumph there in peril. This final triumph should have been completed a long time ago; However it has not been done and it will be our immediate task. In our place there should be one single authority

and only one, that the Government. The organisations and political parties should disarm their militants. Thus they are invited, if they do not do so then it will be necessary to do it by force. In this manner will we be finished with

those who are termed "Incontrolables". Everyone should either accept control or should submit to it. Those who intrigue against the Government and create difficulties to its working as well as those who spend their time in cafes should go to the front. There, they will not have time to indulge in intrigues.

IZNALLOZ 3rd: - The loyal forces in the sector of Granada, Southern Front, have attacked the very strategic position of EL MIGUELLEJO and took it after fierce fighting passing as far as the forest of ALZAGARA.

Valencia 2nd: - The National Committee of the C.N.T. has published a note in order to dispell certain erroneous declarations regarding the subject of the visit made by certain officials of the organisation with the President of the Council Comrade Negrin. The note states that the visit was merely an exchange of views on the possibilities of a collaboration of the C.N.T. with the Government of Dr. NEGRIN.

MADRID 3rd (LATE NEWS) Following an order by the fascists in the Region of Soria our troops have counter attacked viciously and have occupied the position which were held by the rebels prior to their unsuccessful attack.

OVIEDO In the Asturias it is stated our troops have attacked the Gasworks with bombs and destroyed it.
